

Town of Draper
Agreement to Remove Trees within the Right of Way on Town Roads

From time to time the Town of Draper finds it necessary to cut trees from within the right of way of town roads. The general width of a right of way is 66 feet (33 feet in each direction from the center line of the roadway). This form will be used to inform the landowner whose property abuts the roadway of the Town of Draper's intent to cut trees within the right of way along the property indicated below.

Specifications:

1. Trees over or interfering with power lines will be referred to the electric power company (North Central Power).
2. Trees that are interfering with the safe movement of traffic (i.e. hanging into the path of vehicles) or that obscure road signs do not require this permission.
3. All trees included in the agreement will be marked on the stump and lowermost log to allow verification of which trees that will be or have been cut.
4. No cutting will occur (except in an emergency) until this form is delivered to the land owner and signed by that land owner.
5. All logs will be cut into sizes that are manageable by the Town of Draper crew and equipment.
6. All logs are the property of the adjoining land owner and will not be removed from the right of way but they will be piled so that they do not interfere with the safe movement of traffic on the roadway.
7. All cutting of trees will be done by Town of Draper employees, using town equipment and operations will occur during regular business hours for Town of Draper employees.
8. It is the adjacent landowner's responsibility to remove (or have removed) the logs from the right of way.
9. No logs will be removed by Town of Draper employees without the express written consent of the adjacent land owner.
